#### **Background:**

The adoption of the Arms Trade Treaty (ATT) by the United Nations General Assembly in April 2013 represented a key milestone in global efforts to regulate trade in conventional arms. To support the universalization and full implementation of the Treaty, the Council of the European Union adopted Council Decision 2013/768/CFSP on 16 December 2013, setting up the EU Arms Trade Treaty Outreach Project "EU ATT OP". Since then, the project has been renewed twice with the current phase running until January 2025.

Numerous countries have received crucial technical support and assistance on ATT implementation through the project during this time. Currently, 17 countries are partners under the project and are actively working with the two implementing agencies – Expertise France and the German Federal Office for Economic Affairs and Export Control (BAFA) – towards aligning their national systems with the standards set forth in the ATT.
