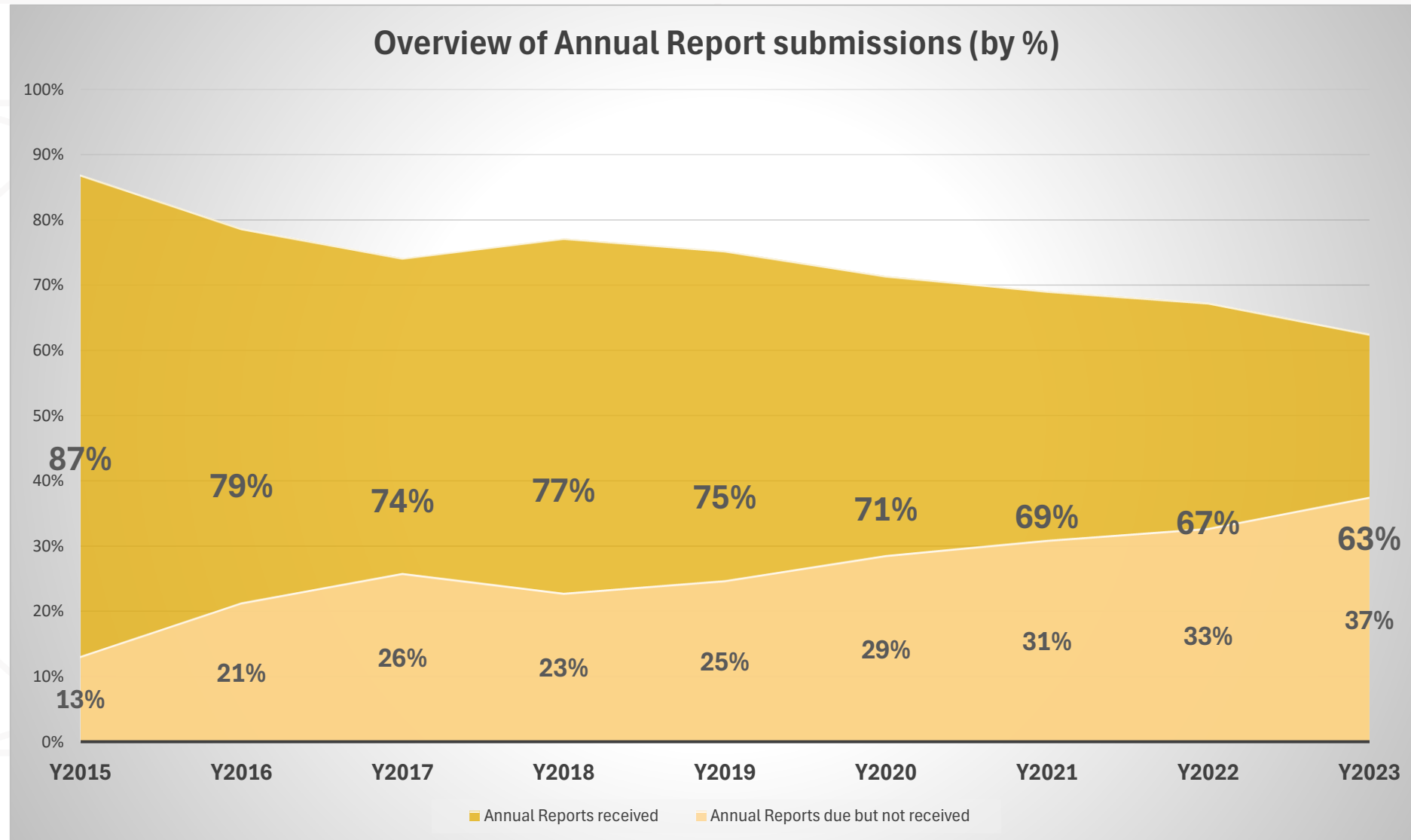

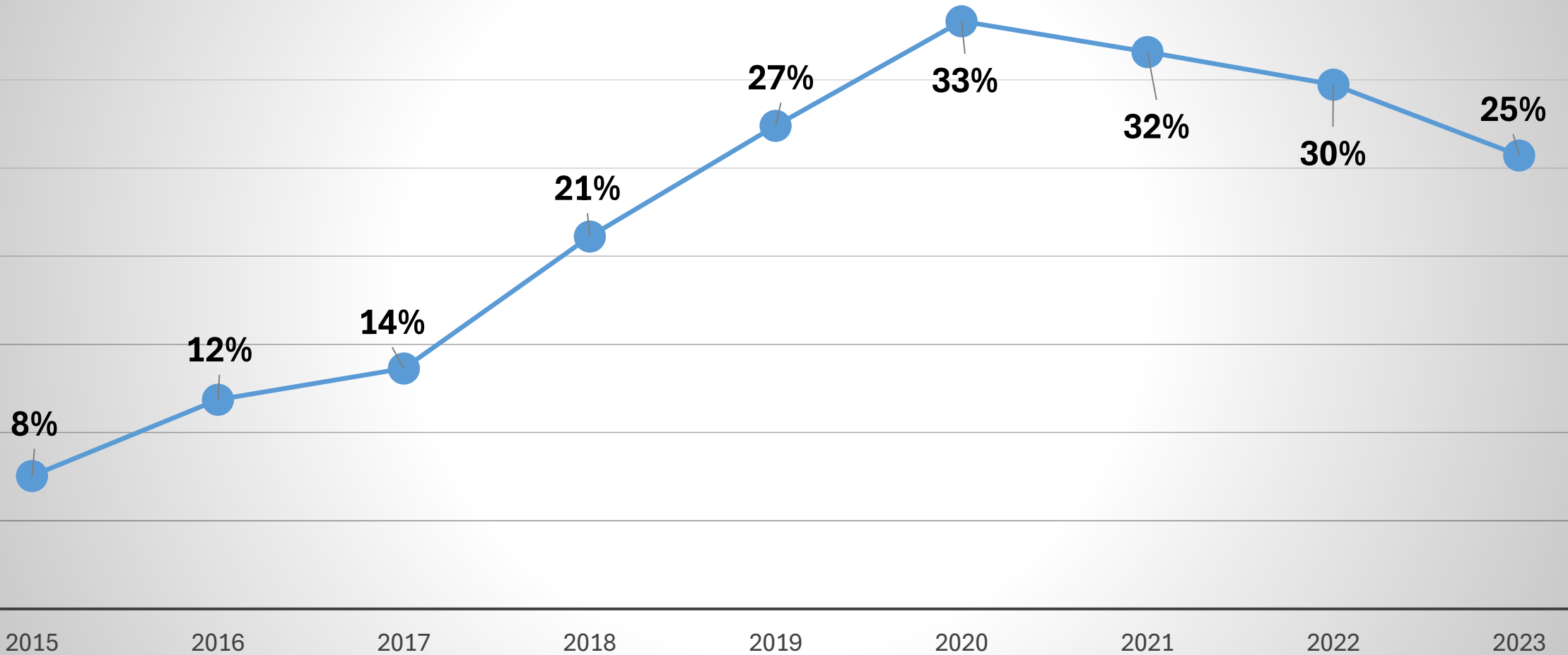

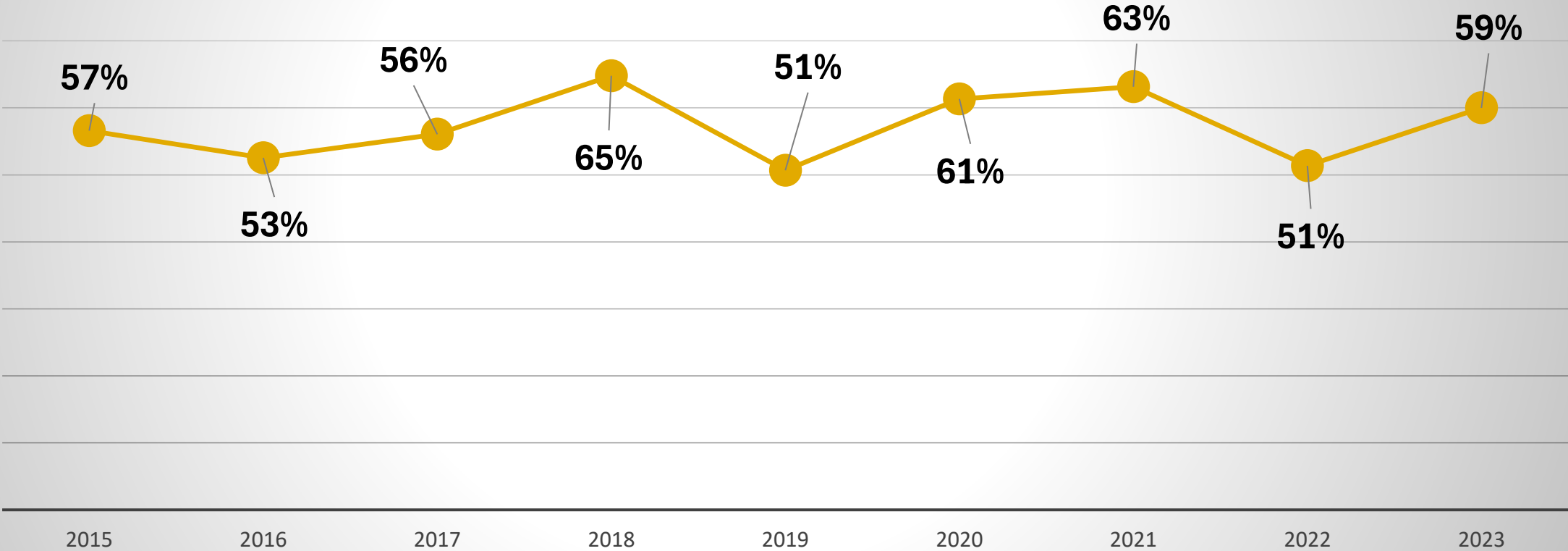

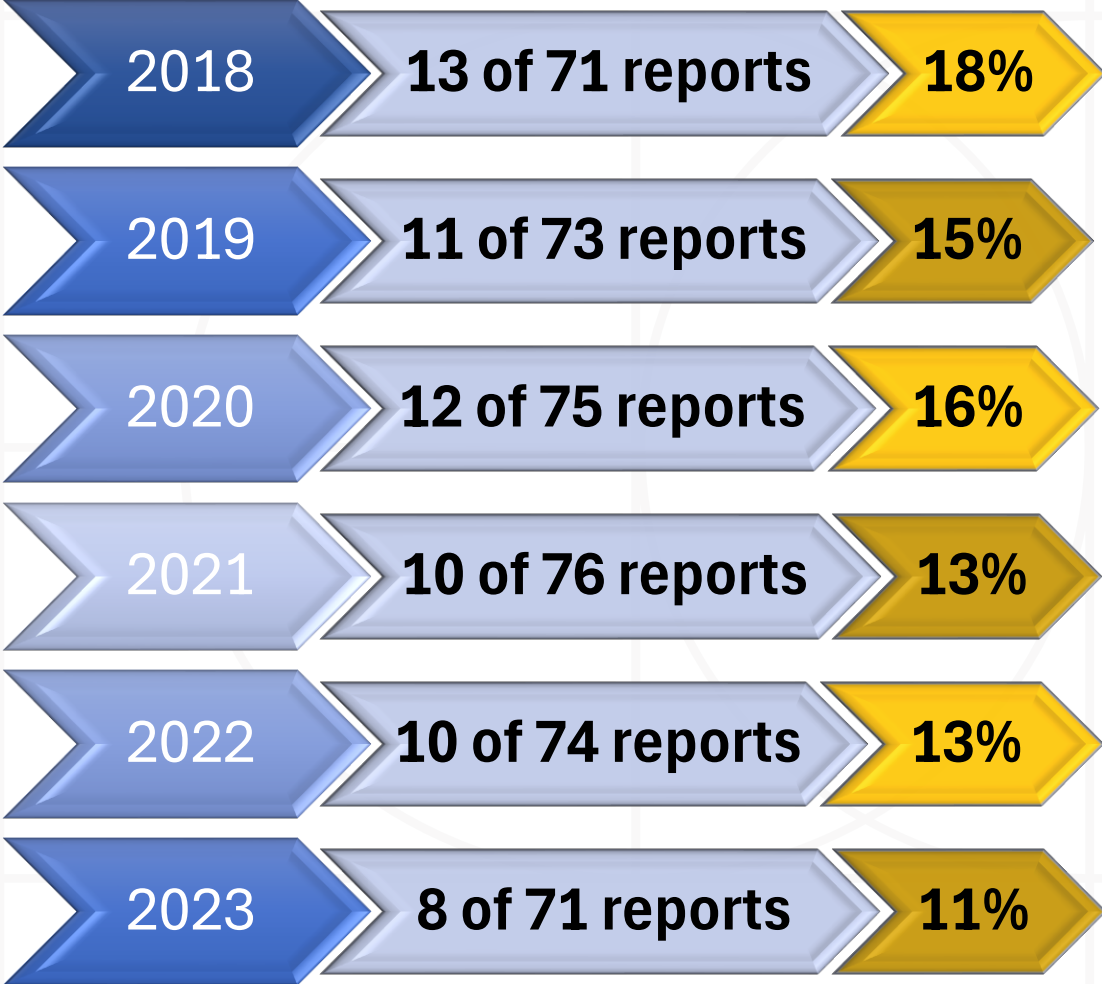

Use of online reporting tool

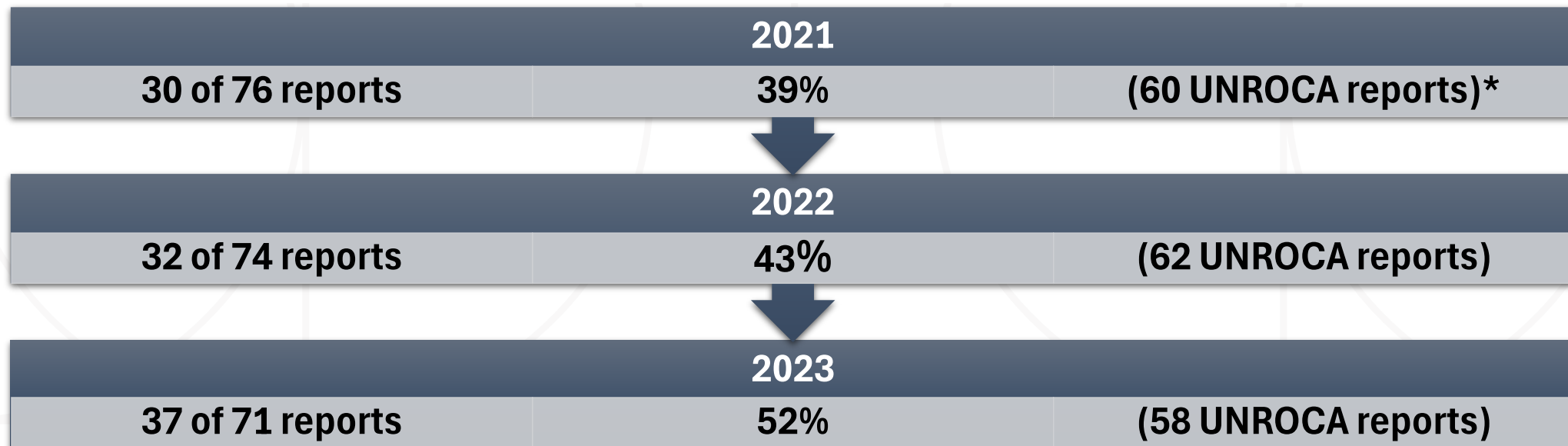
