1. Does grenade launchers include 37/38 Stoppers and less lethal?
2. How does one know if it is under-barrel or mounted?
3. Does mounted mean it must be mountable; e.g. above APC
4. How do we capture weapons with multiple characteristics that are categories on their own; e.g. Portable anti-tank guns and Recoilless rifles? There is information suggesting that the **Carl Gustaf is an 84 mm man-portable** reusable anti-tank recoilless rifle produced by SAA Bofors Dynamics in Sweden. Its characteristics are:
 - a. **Portable Anti-tank gun/rifle**
 - b. **Recoilless**
5. What are the responsibilities of National Point of Contact for the ATT Report?
