•	Appointed the VTF Selection Committee (13 States Parties) for 2 years (CSP8 – CSP10)	
•	Appointed China to replace the Republic of Korea as member of the Management Committee	

Post Shipment Controls



	Decision	Progress
•	States Parties are encouraged to continue discussing approaches and understandings of "post-shipment controls" or "post-delivery coordination" in the context of diversion control.	✓ Art. 11 focus area of discussion
•	States Parties are encouraged, where appropriate and on strictly voluntary basis, to share experiences regarding the implementation of PSC measures within the scope of the ATT, through various means, without setting additional burdens beyond the obligations of the Treaty.	✓ ongoing

Treaty Universalization



Decision	Progress
 Welcomed the draft paper "Enhancing the work of the Working Group on Treaty Universalization", and requested Germany to further work on this issue as WGTU Co-chair during the next CSP cycle and to present recommendations to CSP9 	
 Encouraged continued regular exchanges of views on Treaty universalization 	✓ ongoing

Treaty Implementation



Decision

Art 6 & 7

- noted the completion of draft Chapter 1 (Key concepts) of \checkmark Voluntary Guide to assist States Parties in implementing Articles 6 and 7.
- noted that Chapter 2 (Prohibitions) will be elaborated during CSP9 cycle
- upon completion, the proposed Voluntary Guide should be submitted to Conference for endorsement.

Art 9

noted that draft elements for a possible voluntary guide on draft presented in February on Article 9 will be developed during CSP9 cycle

Art 11

noting the end of multi-year plan, extended the work of this Group by one additional year to enable it to focus on the topic of post-delivery cooperation

- ongoing programme of work for the sub-working group
 - relationship between Article 6 and other Articles, and thereafter proceed to mitigations measures
- draft presented in February

 Endorsed the revised 'FAQ'-type guidance document on the annual reporting obligation

 Encouraged all States Parties and Signatory States to present cases of diversion at forthcoming DIEF meetings 	✓ DIEF Chair will set out the plan for the year

Sponsorship Programme (SP)	
 Highlighted the value of SP in facilitating broad and diverse participation in ATT meetings. 	 managed according to its governing rules and supporting diverse participation
 Encouraged states to make voluntary contributions to SP 	
Voluntary Trust Fund (VTF)	
 Highlighted the importance of VTF in supporting national Treaty implementation efforts 	
 Decided that in selecting VTF projects, the VTF Selection Committee will continue to be guided by the VTF Terms of Reference. 	

Management Committee

 Tasked the Management Committee to review the ATT programme of work and to submit a proposal to CSP9 for a decision. 	 MC in the process of undertaking this task
 Considerations for review: ATT universalization and implementation objectives; optimisation of the ATT internal support processes; financial efficiencies; and disarmament calendar.
