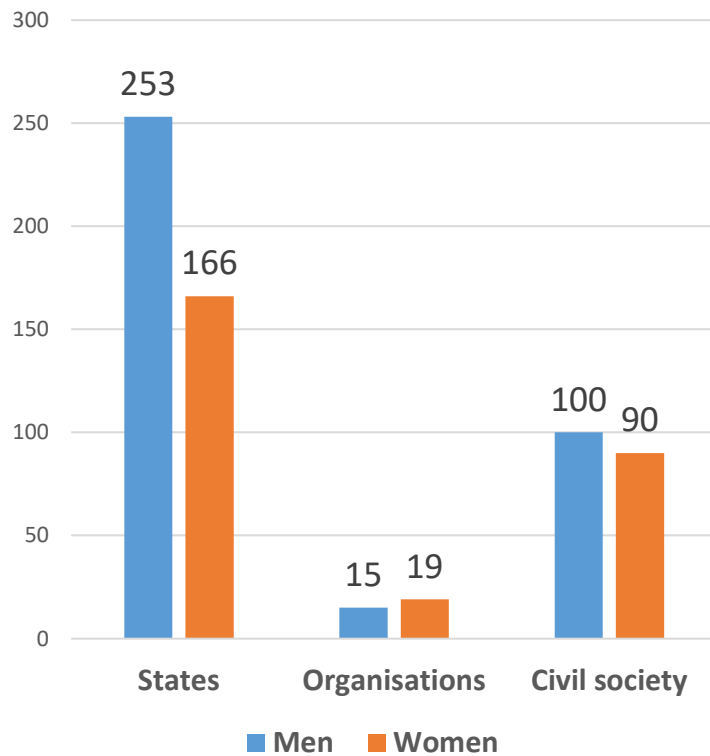

Data limitations

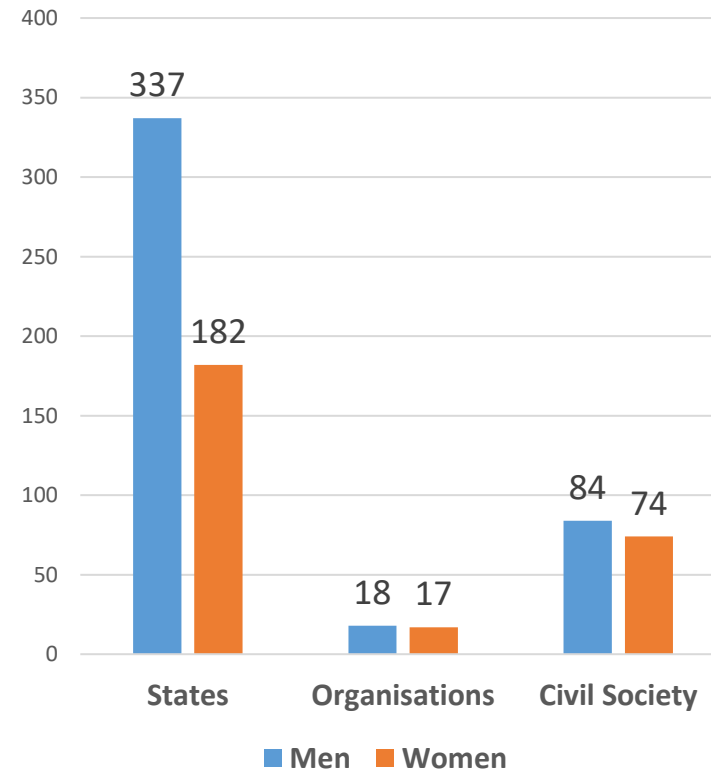
- Migration to new website in 2018

Participation: by no. of delegates

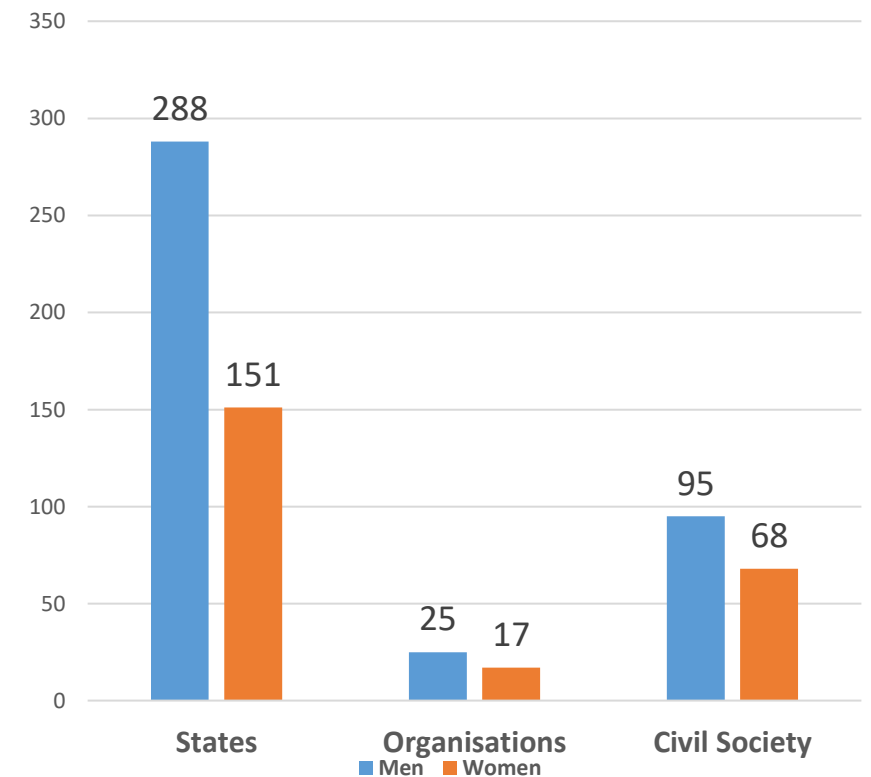

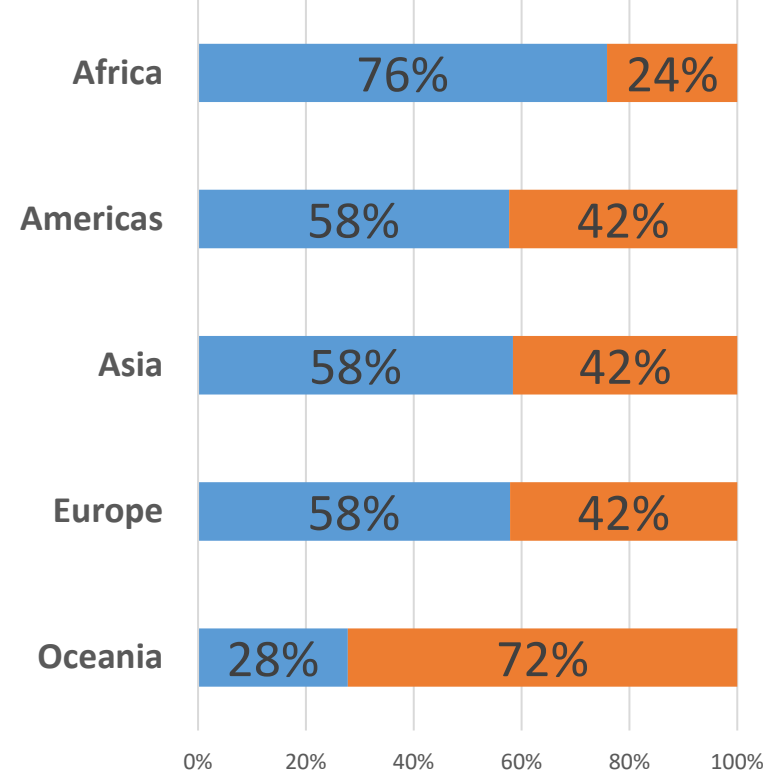
Gender balance among delegates (in %)



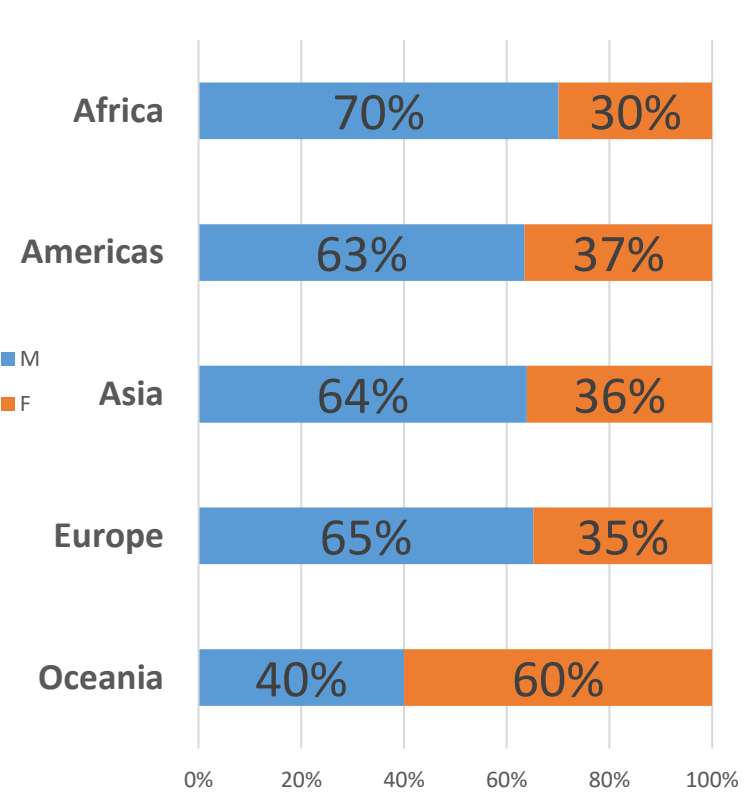
Gender balance among State delegates

By region (in %)

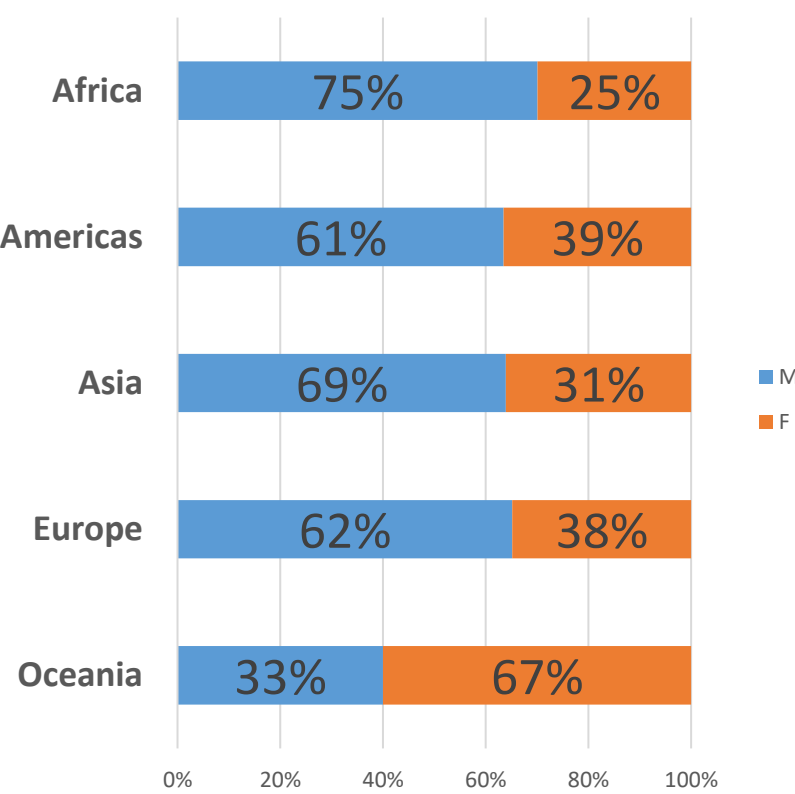

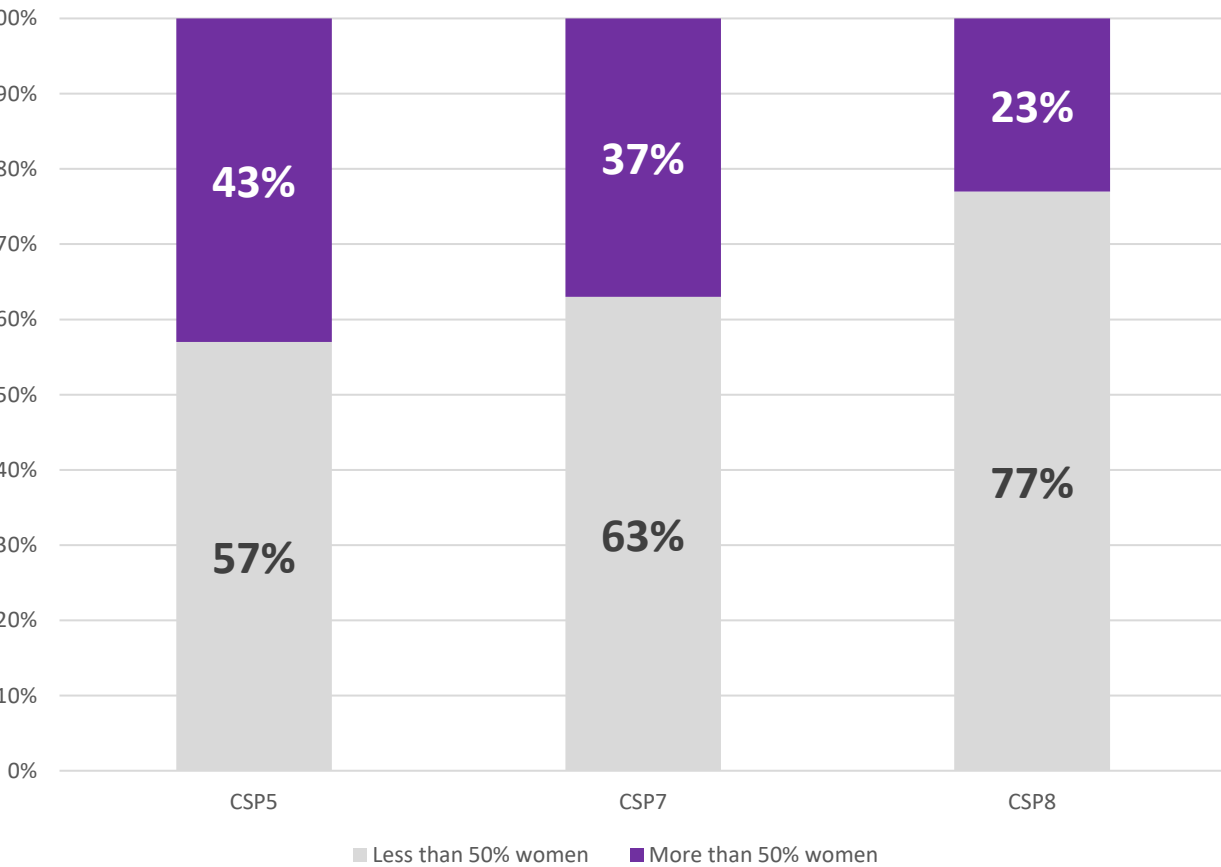


Participation: by no. of delegations (by no.)

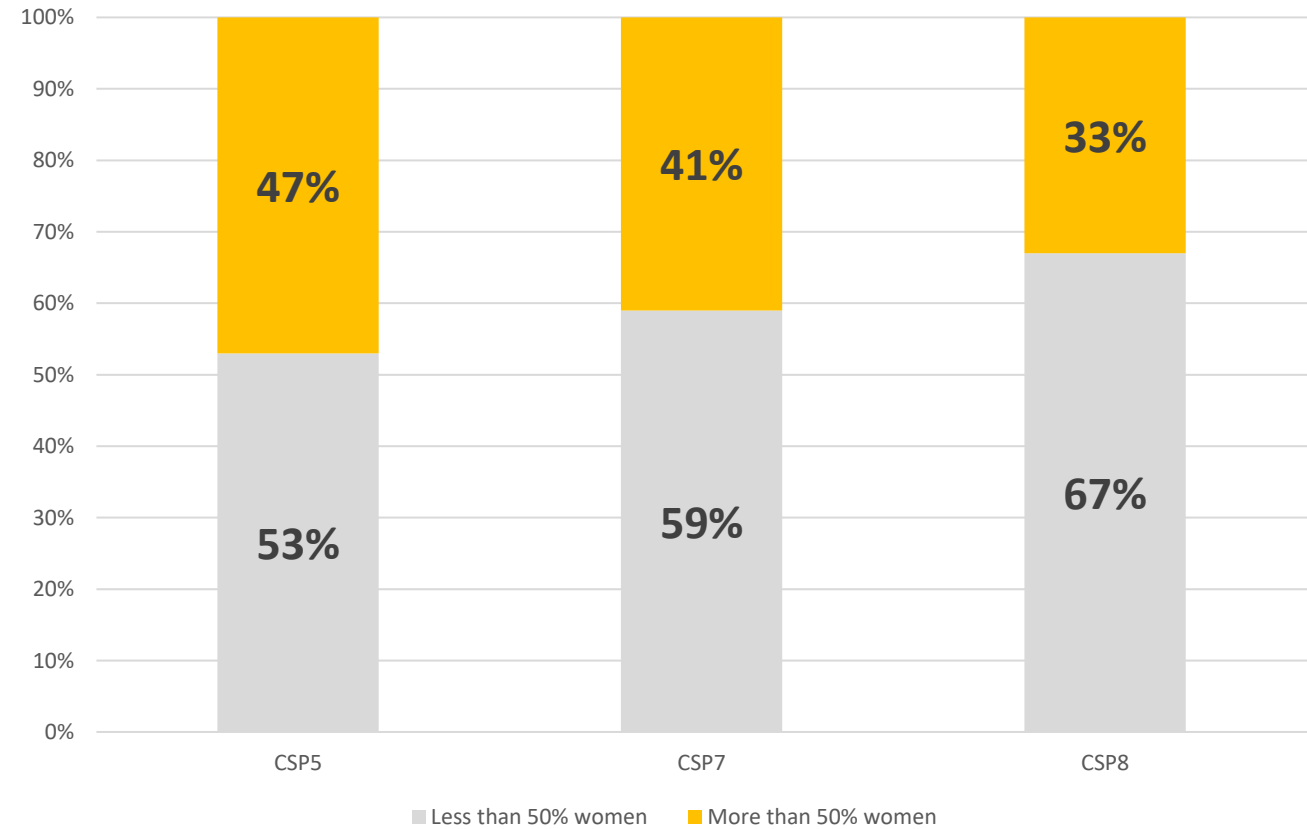


Participation: by no. of delegations (by %)

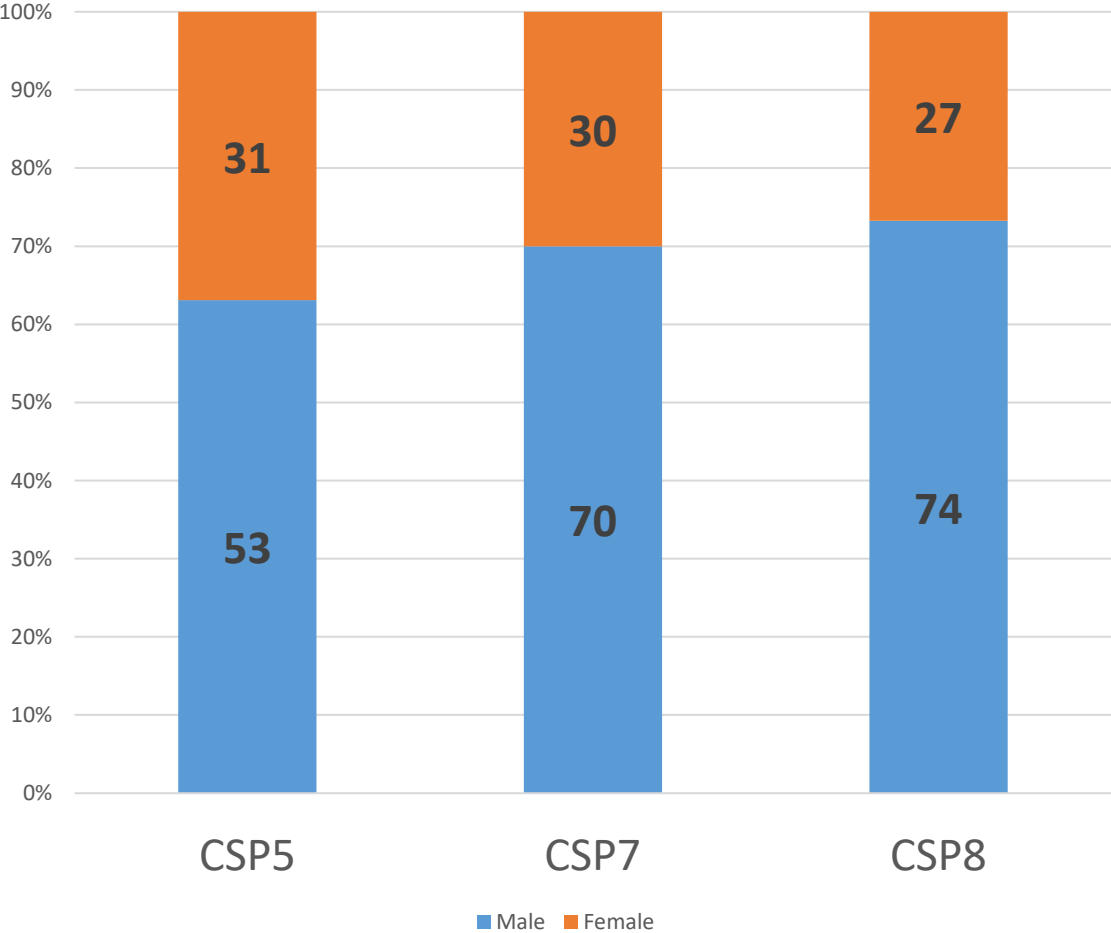

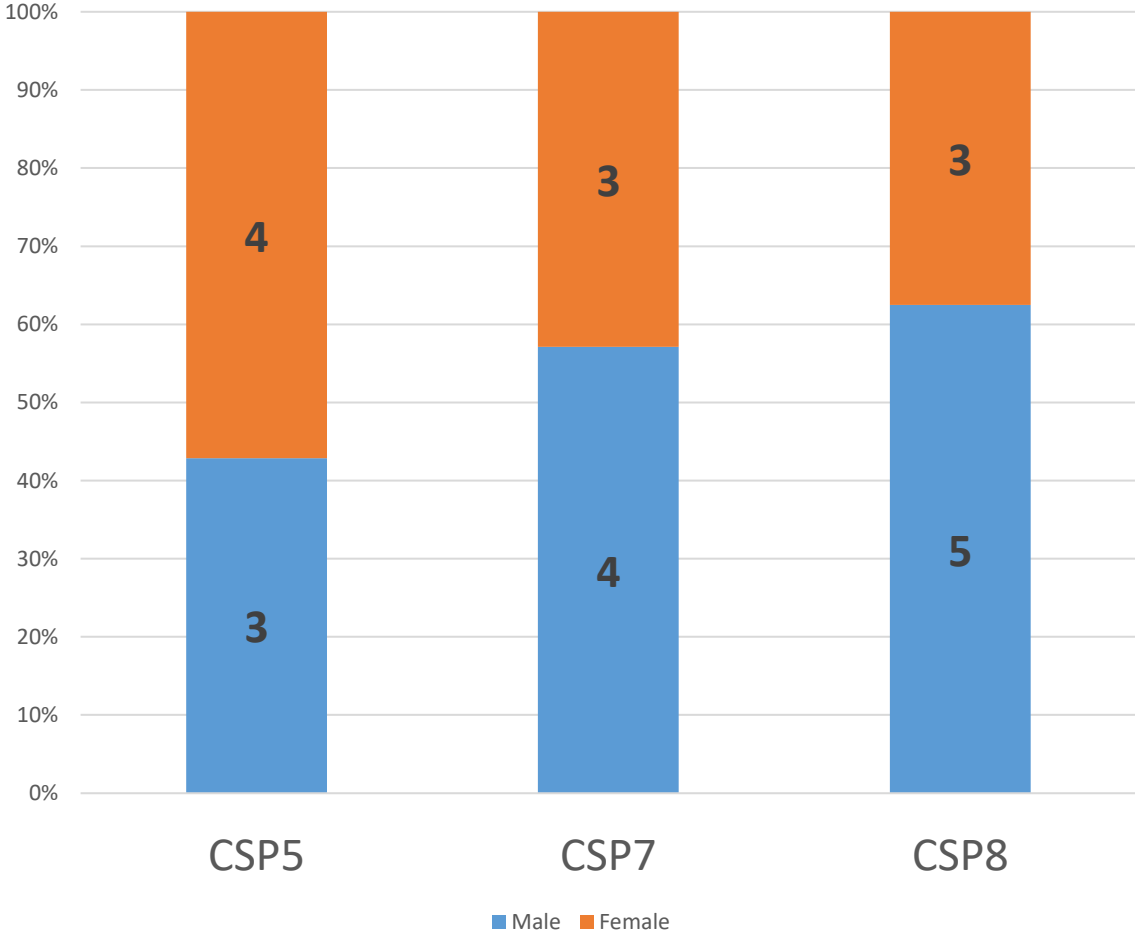

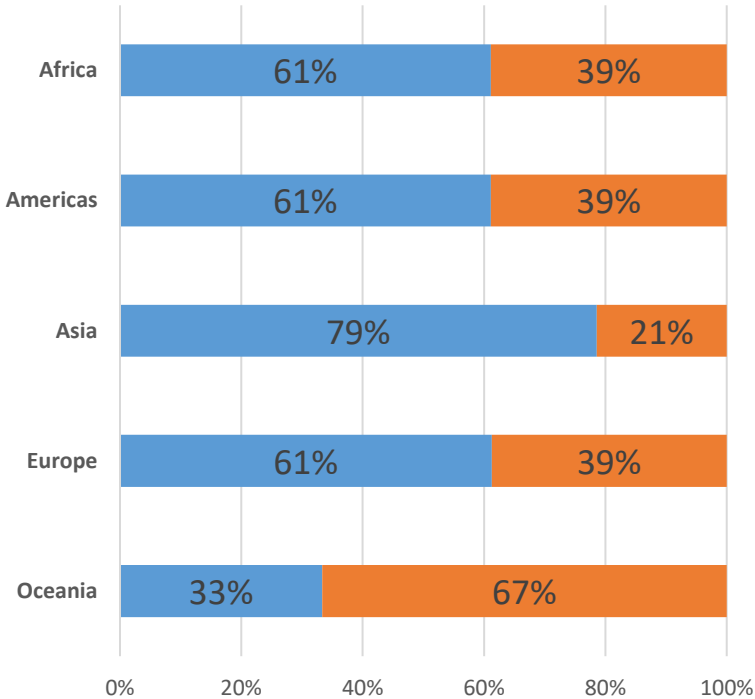

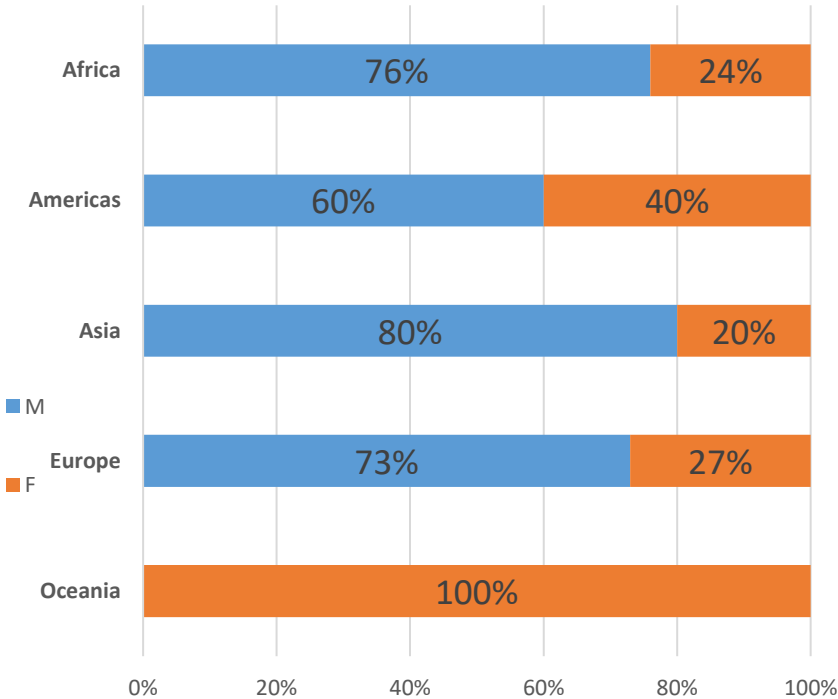
Heads of delegation: States

By region (in %)

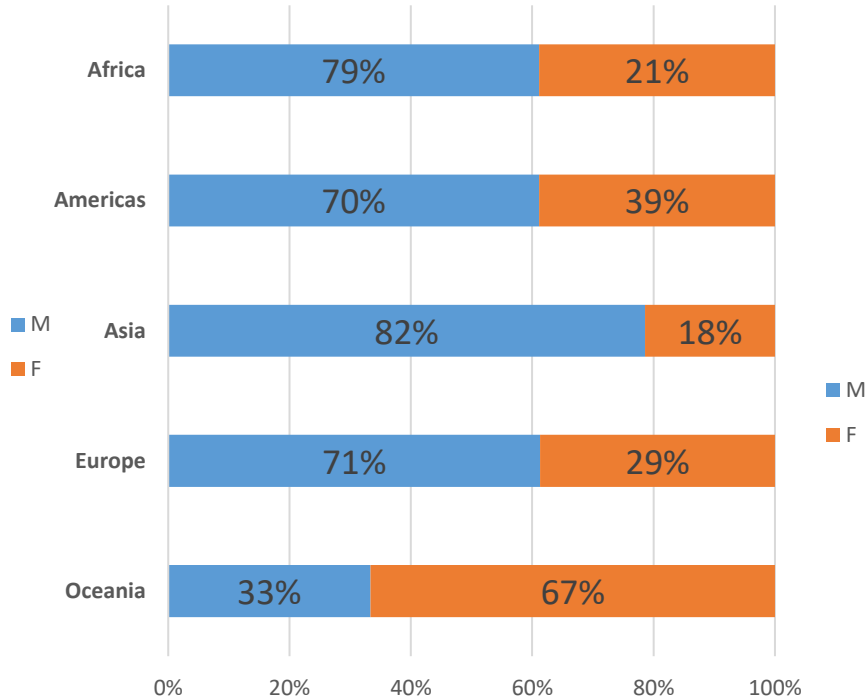
