

**ATT SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMME: CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR CSP5**

1. A limited sponsorship programme is available for States wishing to attend the Fifth Conference of States Parties (CSP5) taking place in Geneva, Switzerland, from 26 – 30 August 2019.
2. States wishing to apply for sponsorship to attend CSP5 are invited to nominate one (1) representative and to submit the following documents to the ATT Secretariat at [info@thearmstradetreaty.org](mailto:info@thearmstradetreaty.org):
  - a. **Note Verbale** signed by the relevant Government institution nominating the representative for sponsorship;
  - b. **Application form** completed by the nominated representative (attached);
  - c. Copy of the applicant's **passport**; and
  - d. Copy of the applicant's **health insurance policy** (if the applicant has one).
3. The deadline for the submission of applications for CSP5 is **03 June 2019**. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.
4. Please note that if you/your State has already applied for funding to attend CSP5, and this application was acknowledged by the ATT Secretariat, you do not need to resubmit your application for sponsorship.
5. It is brought to the attention of States that the process to raise funds from donors to support the sponsorship programme is currently underway and as such no definite budget exists yet for the sponsorship programme. In view of this, the number of delegates to be sponsored to participate in CSP5 will be subject to the availability of funds.
6. The ATT Secretariat looks forward to receiving applications to the sponsorship programme and to welcoming sponsored delegates to CSP5.
