# Required/encouraged actions on inter-agency cooperation

- share experiences, lessons learned, and effective practices on the role of interagency cooperation
- contribute to updating of existing voluntary guidance to support effective implementation
- develop a voluntary paper on key elements for effective interagency cooperation in ATT implementation

ATT Working Groups **should**

- include the cross-cutting issue of interagency in the agenda

States Parties

are encouraged to

- continue discussing issues concerning the practical implementation and application of Arts. 6 & 7

States parties and other  
ATT stakeholders

are encouraged to

- volunteer to give presentations for these and subsequent topics in the multi-year workplan

WGETI SwG

is requested to

- continue discussing the identified issues concerning the role of industry and the risk of arms being used in violation of Arts. 6 & 7

# Required/encouraged actions on WGETI

States Parties and other interested parties

**are encouraged to**

- recommit to CSP5 decisions and encourage regular exchanges on those decisions
- consider appointing gender focal points
- engage with national institutions working GBV and VAWC

Future CSP Presidents

**are invited to**

- review the implementation of the decisions adopted by CSP5

States Parties and other stakeholders

**are encouraged to**

- raise further implementation issues on which they seek an ad hoc discussion

# Required/encouraged actions on WGTR



States Parties that are not fully compliant

**are urged to**

- submit their reports or make use of the available assistance mechanisms to address their challenge

Regional reporting champions

**are encouraged to**

- cooperate with regional organisations to raise awareness of ATT reporting obligations & enhance their reporting capacity

States Parties and other ATT stakeholders

**are encouraged to**

- take initiatives to raise awareness and assist States Parties not compliant with the reporting obligations
- volunteer to give presentations for the different topics included in the draft multi-year workplan

States Parties and signatory States

**are encouraged to**

- exchange information on matters regarding the implementation of the ATT

# Required/encouraged actions on DIEF

States Parties and signatory States **are encouraged to**

- actively use the DIEF as a means prevent and eradicate diversion

States Parties and signatory States **are encouraged to**

- facilitate the participation of enforcement officials in DIEF meetings

# Required/encouraged actions on VTF / sponsorship

**States Parties are encouraged to**

- contribute to the [ATT Sponsorship] Programme
- contribute to the [VTF] in support of Treaty implementation and universalisation

**Eligible States Parties are encouraged to**

- consider applying to the VTF to mitigate the risk of GBV and VAWC

# Required/encouraged actions on Secretariat and Management Committee

States with financial  
arrears

**are called on to**

- address their financial obligations and make use of the financial mechanism for the settlement of arrears

Management Committee

**is tasked to**

- Assess the revised ATT programme of work, [...], and to report its assessment and recommendations, [...] to the CSP11 for a decision

ATT Secretariat

**is called on to**

- collect gender-disaggregated attendance data during ATT Working Group and Preparatory meetings

All stakeholders

**are encouraged to**

- have gender balanced panels in plenary sessions, side events and other forums
