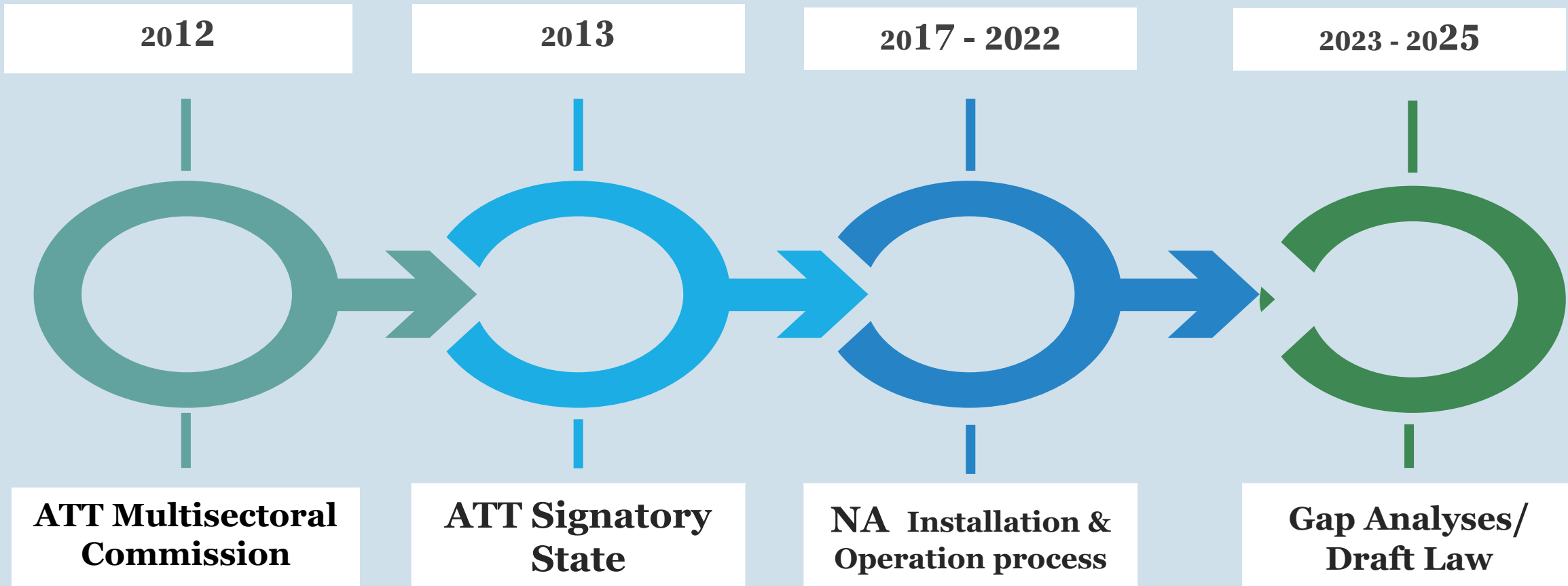

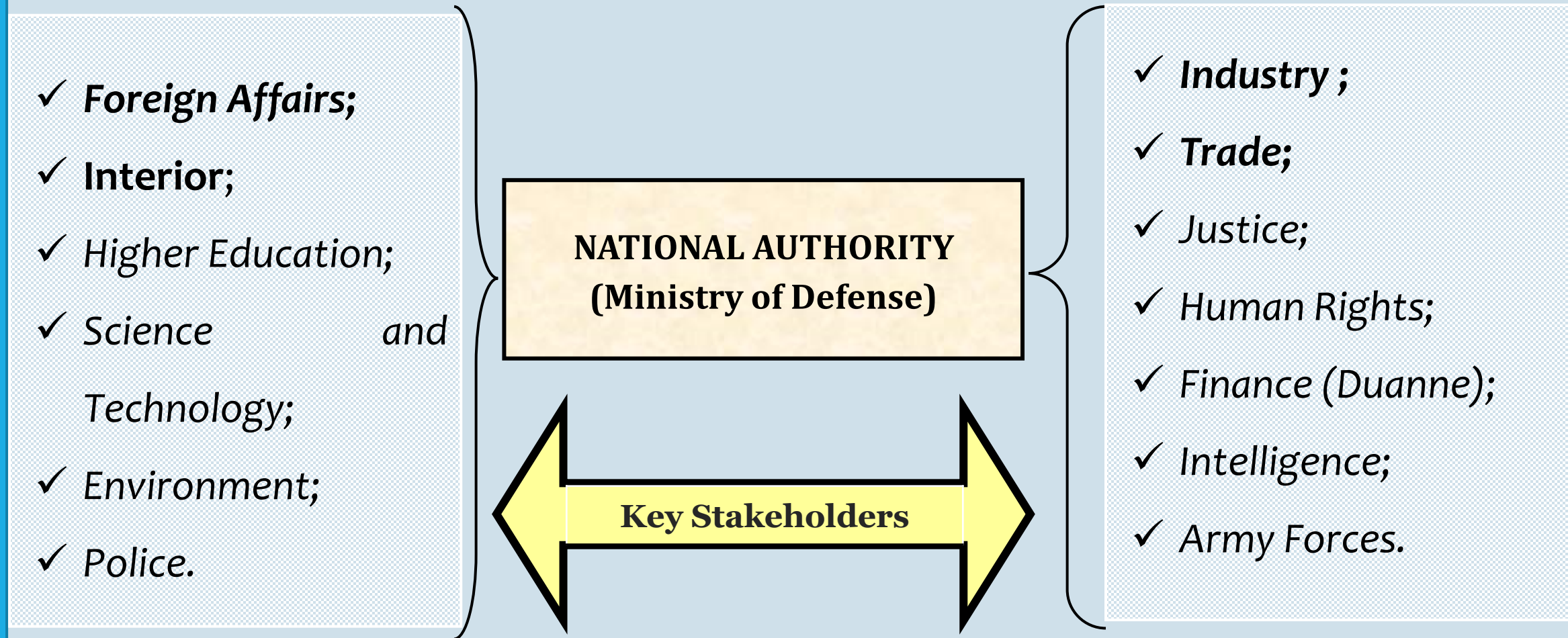

2º

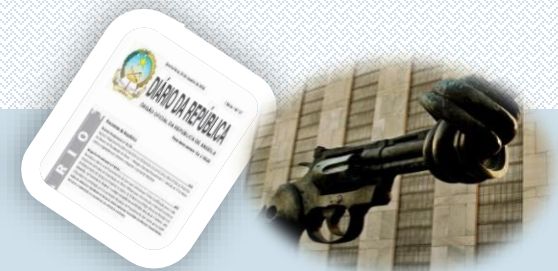
- Approval by the **PARLIAMENT**
(formal role in the process)

- **Ratification** by the P. R.
(Legal Competence)

4. RATIFICATION & THE NATIONAL LAWS FOR THE ATT

1. The conformity of national laws plays a vital role in the ratification process of the ATT;
2. *Current approach*: **promote and advance both primary legislation approval and ATT ratification**;
3. **Actions required**: (1) Finalize and adopt the Conventional Weapons, Ammunition, and Related Materials Bill; (2) Support from the ATT Secretariat through the VTF;
4. Important Note: Actions approved in the National Authority's Biannual Action Plan (2026-2027).
