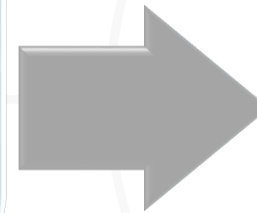

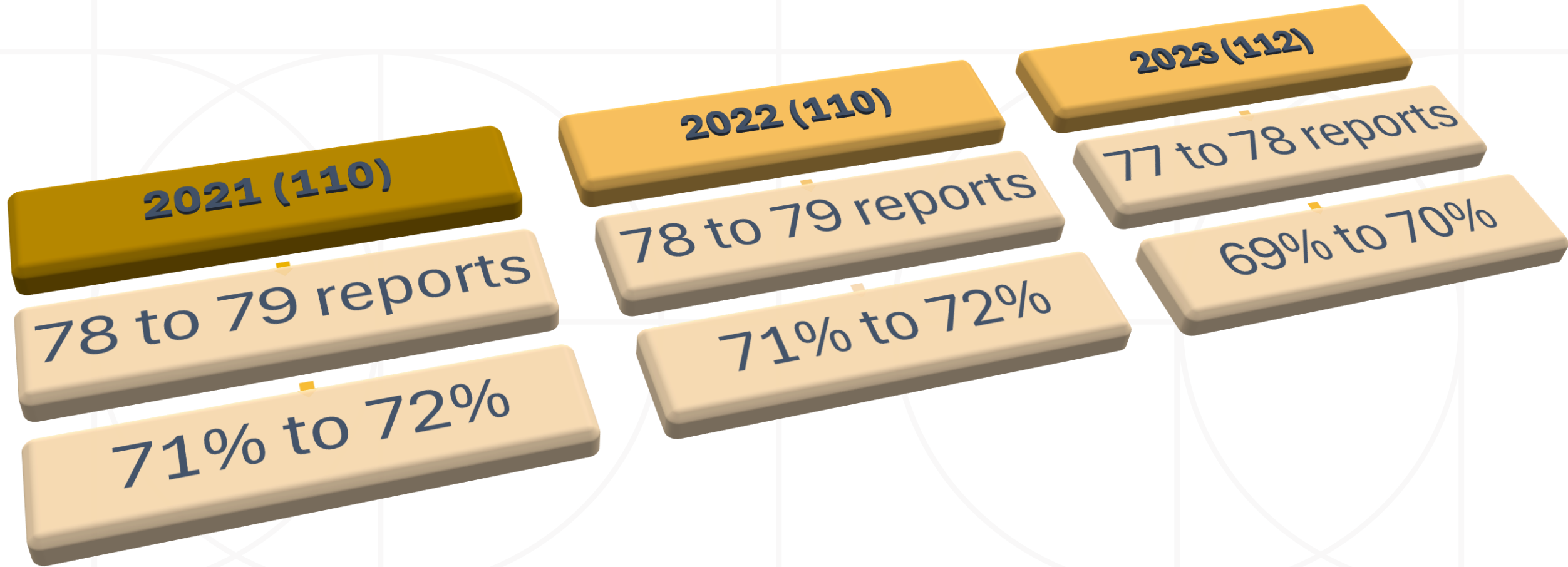

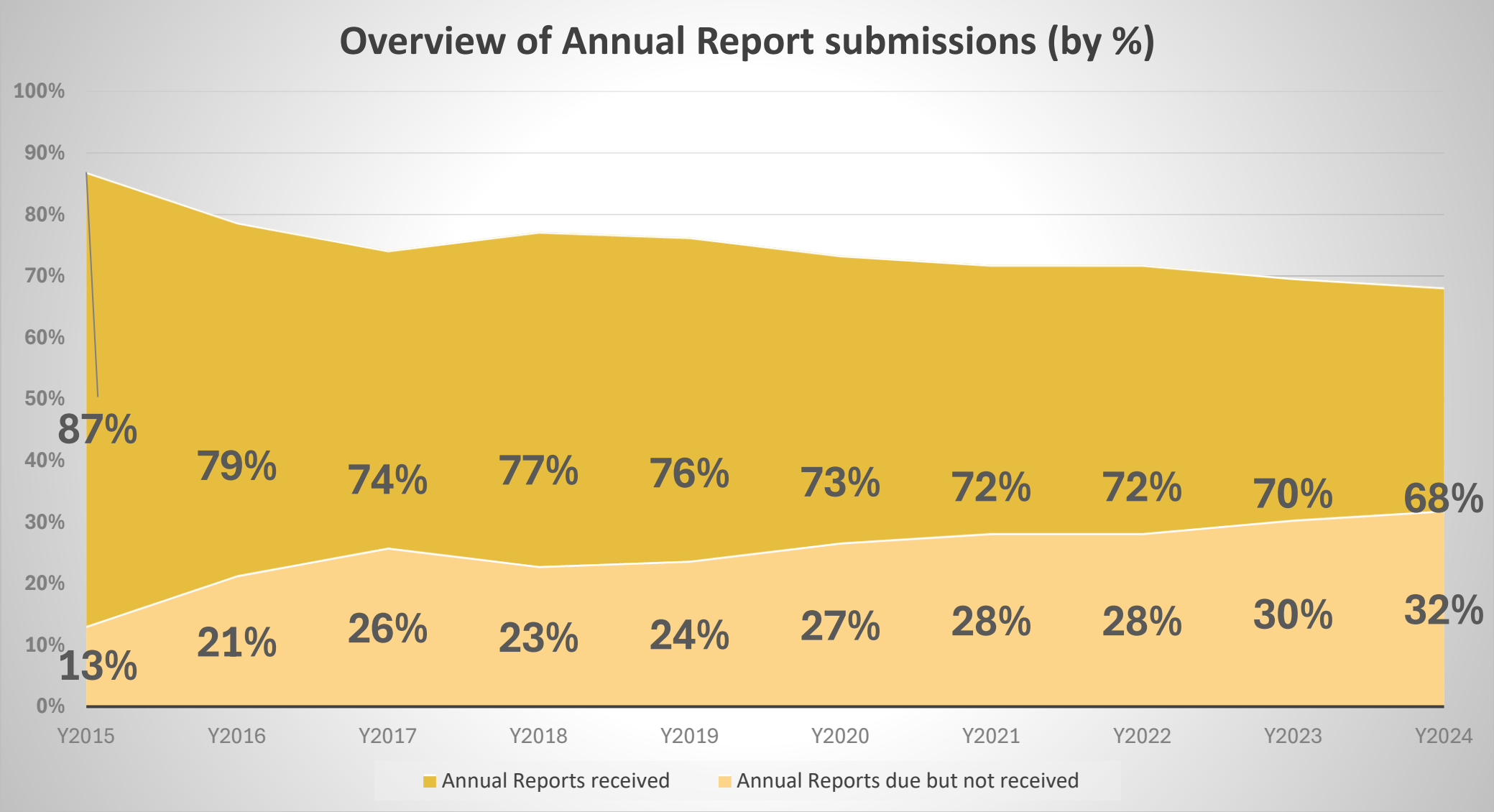

For calendars years 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019 respectively 5, 2, 1 and 1 additional reports were submitted which were not due at that moment.

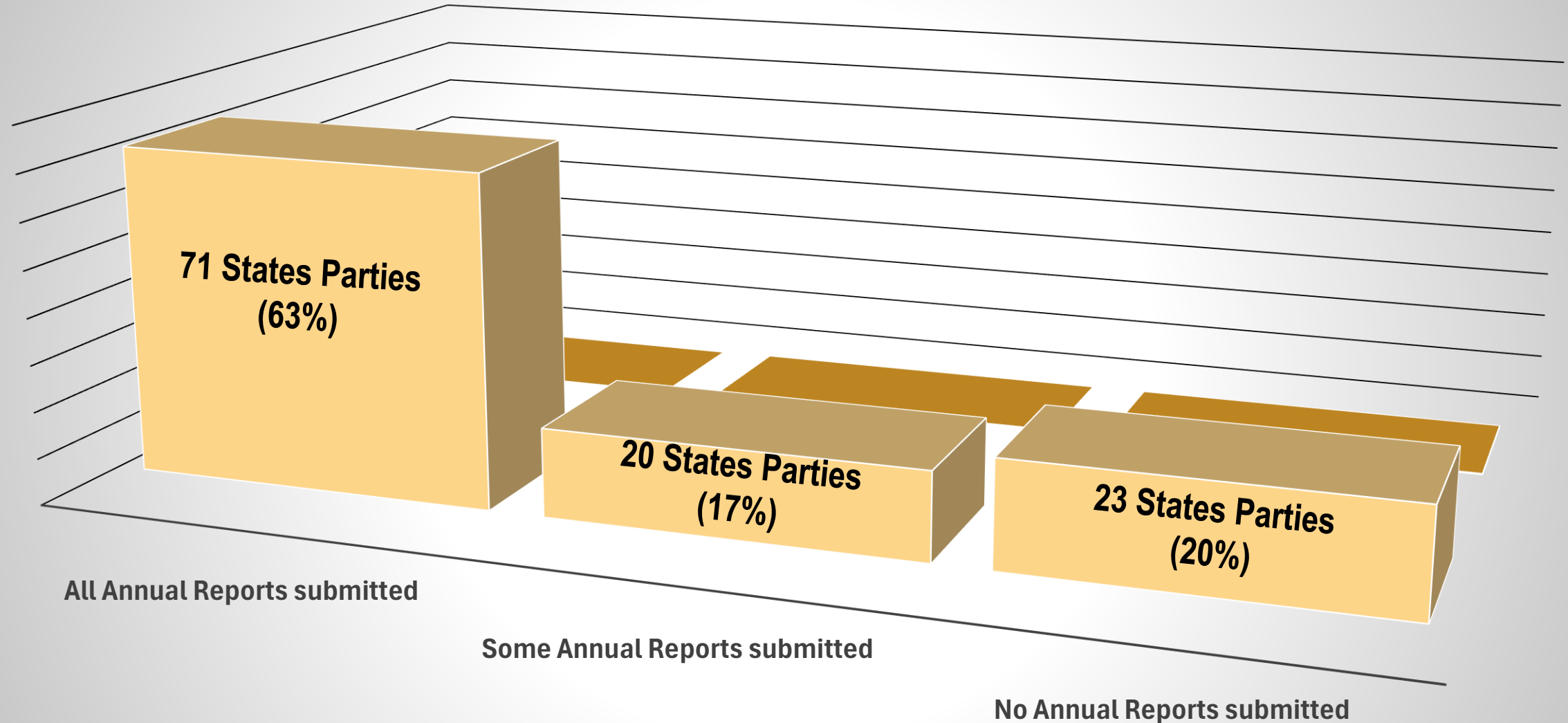

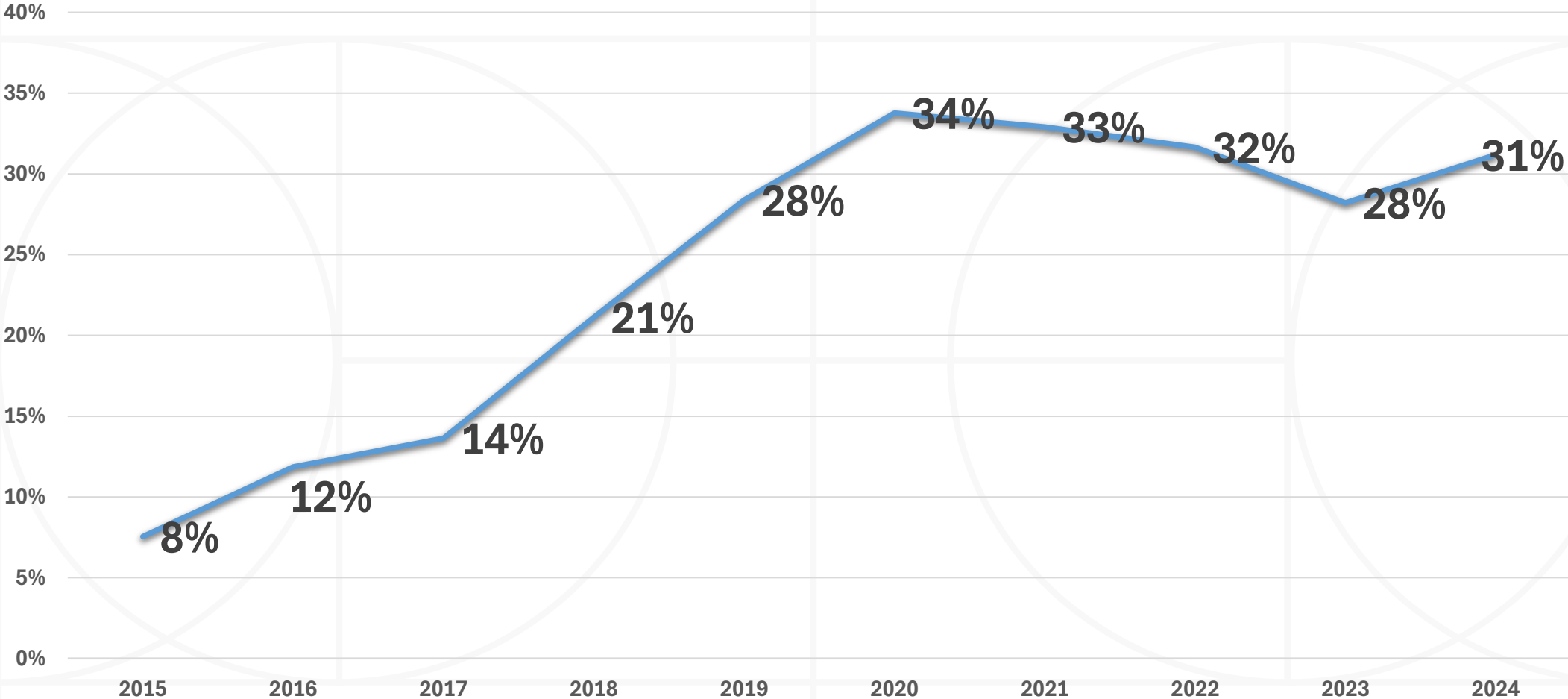

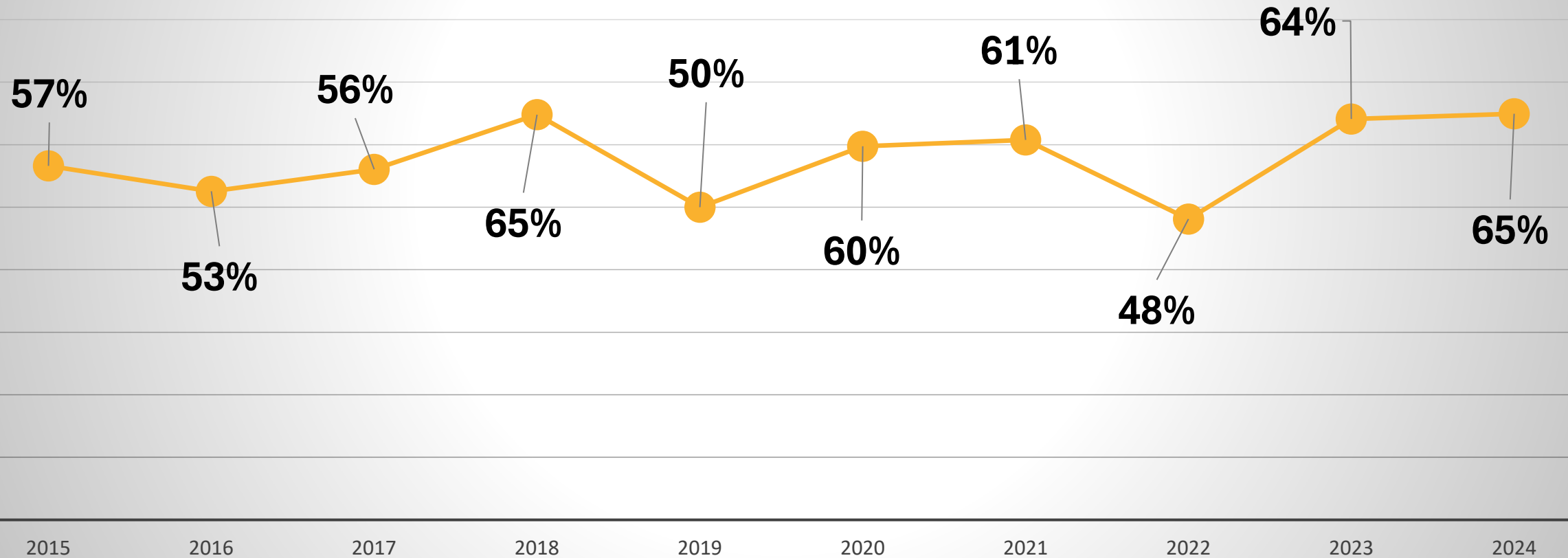

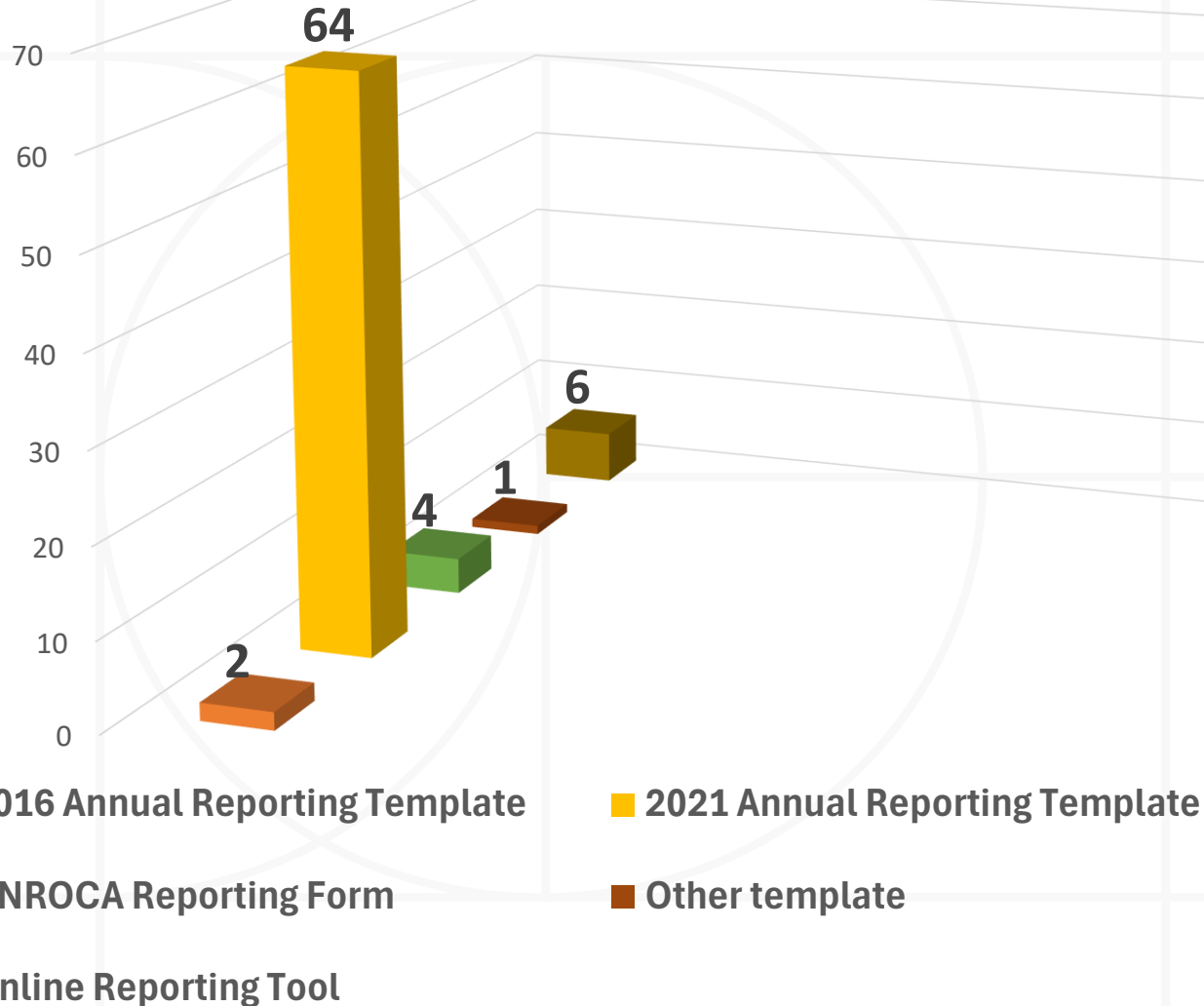

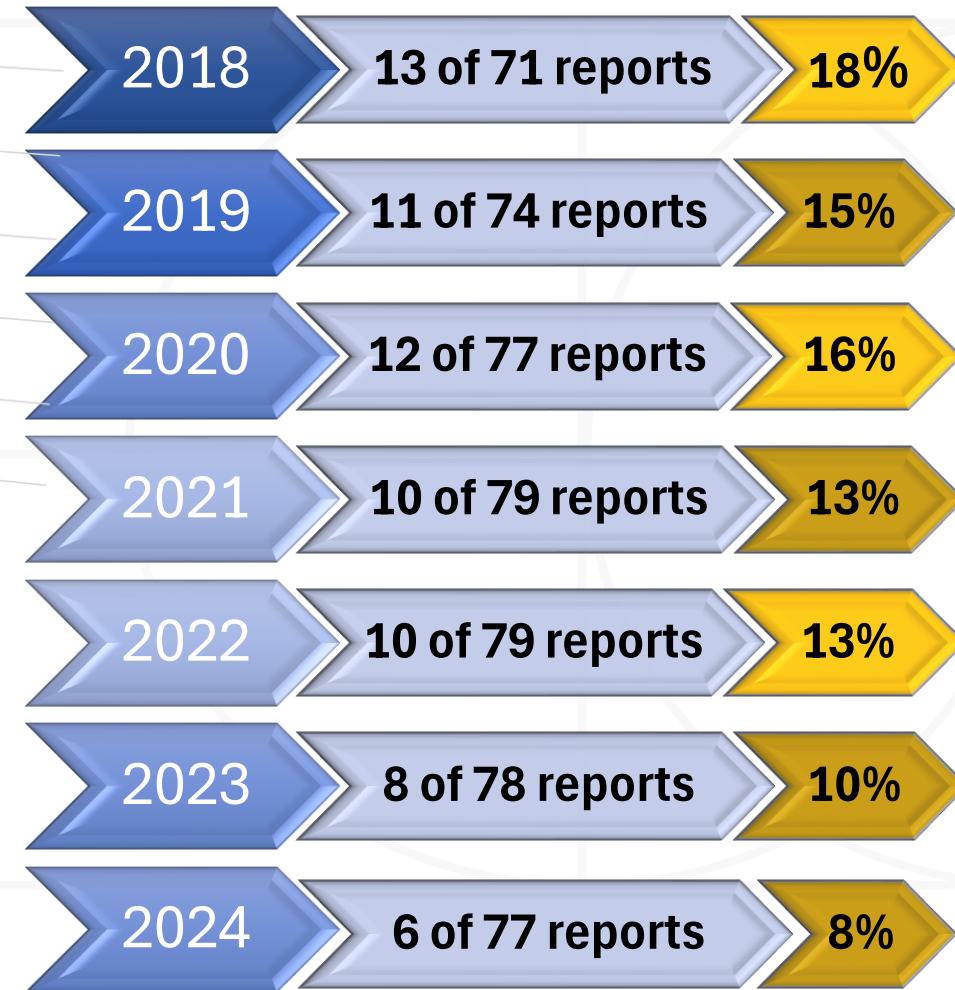

Use of online reporting tool



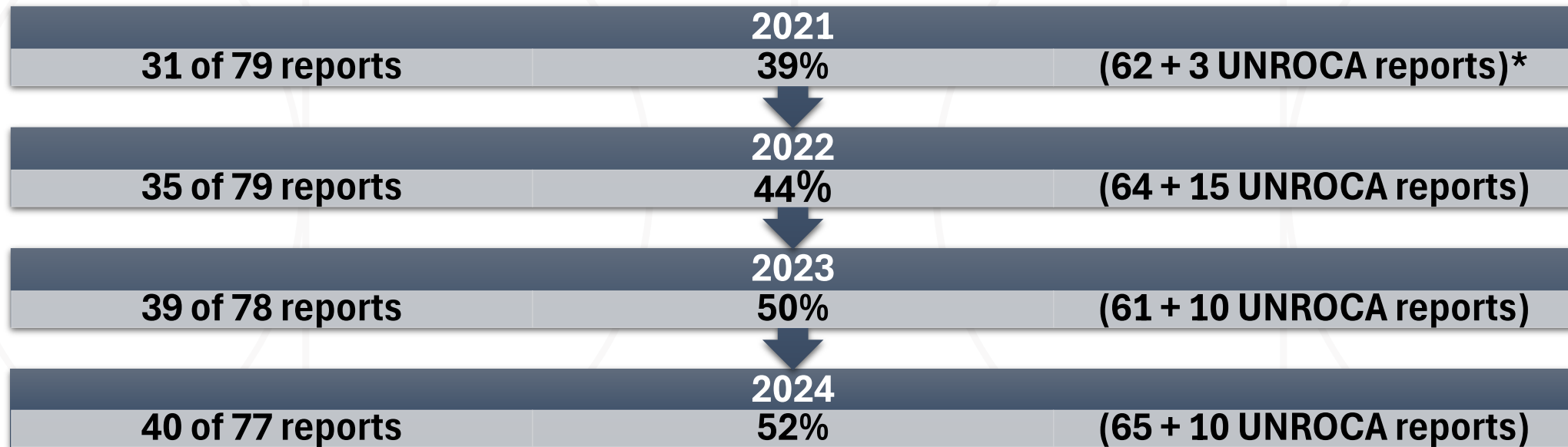
