INVITATION TO THE ATT CSP10 INFORMAL PREPARATORY MEETING: 16 - 17 MAY 2024

- 1. Following my announcement circulated on 20 November 2023 regarding the schedule of ATT meetings for the period leading up to CSP10, I have the pleasure to invite you to the CSP10 Informal Preparatory Meeting, which will take place on 16-17 May 2024.
- 2. Registration

This applies to delegates who will participate remotely, as well as delegates who will attend the meeting in-person. Registration for the meeting involves one step: each individual member of each delegation must register online (here). Anyone who has not registered for the

meeting will not receive the Zoom link to access the meeting and may not be admitted to the online platform for the meeting.

Remote participation (via online platform)

- 6. Access to the online platform: Delegates that have registered for the meeting will receive the link to the meeting on 15 May 2024.
- 7. Interpretation from/into Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish will also be available for those delegates participating remotely (via the online platform).
- 8. Delegates who are participating remotely (via the online platform) are encouraged to:
 - a. ensure that the name of the State or Organization they represent and their surname are displayed in their Zoom profile. This will help the meeting facilitators to identify participants correctly, if they are called on to speak.
 - b. use a headset with integrated microphone for purposes of audibility and interpretation.
