INVITATION TO THE ATT CSP10 WORKING GROUP MEETINGS: 20 - 23 FEBRUARY 2024

1. The Ninth Conference States Parties (CSP9) to the Arms Trade Treaty held on 21 - 25 August 2023 established an informal preparatory process for the Tenth Conference of States Parties (CSP10).
