The EU ATT Outreach Programme

The EU mandated Expertise France and the German Federal Office for Economic Affairs and Export Control (BAFA) to implement the second phase of the EU's activities in support of the implementation of the Arms Trade Treaty (Council Decision CFSP 2017/915). The main objectives of this programme are to promote the effective implementation of the ATT by supporting beneficiary countries in strengthening their arms transfer control systems, and to work towards the universal adoption of the treaty. The priorities are defined with each partner country, either through a three-year roadmap established jointly, or through tailor made ad-hoc activities.

The EU outreach activities, as well as regional trends and obstacles facing ATT implementation, will be outlined by the two implementers. This will be followed by a presentation of the best practices and results achieved from representatives of the partner countries, Burkina Faso and Chile.
