**SUBJECT: DECISION ON WGETI SUB-WORKING GROUPS' MULTI-YEAR WORKPLANS AND MANDATE OF MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE FOR CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION VIA SILENCE PROCEDURE**

1. I refer to my letter of 21 January 2021 announcing the outcomes of consultations to discuss resolving CSP6 draft decisions not approved.
2. As contemplated in paragraphs 5, 7 and 8 of that letter, attached are two draft decisions for consideration and adoption by States Parties to the Arms Trade Treaty via silence procedure.
3. During these exceptional and extraordinary circumstances presented by the pandemic, I take this opportunity to reaffirm my commitment to conduct the work of CSP7, including the intersessional work, in a transparent and inclusive manner. In addition, the proposal to adopt the attached draft decisions via silence procedure should not be construed as constituting a precedent for our future work.
