## Annex to the Report of the Working Group on Transparency and Reporting (WGTR) to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of ATT States Parties

## Recommendations

- The WGTR proposes that the topic of Compliance with Mandatory Reporting Obligations be added to the agenda of Conferences of States Parties in order to allow for regular review.
- The WGTR proposes that the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of States Parties endorses the document "National-Level Measures to Facilitate Compliance with International Reporting Obligations" [document identifier] and recommends it to States Parties for consideration.
- The WGTR proposes that the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of States Parties endorses the document "Guidance for Reporting Authorized or Actual Exports and Imports of Conventional Arms" [document identifier] and instructs the Secretariat to make it available on the ATT website as a resource for States Parties when preparing their mandatory annual report.
- The WGTR proposes that the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of States Parties mandates the ATT Secretariat to prepare a guidance document for national Points of Contact describing the role and possible tasks for that function, including that of ensuring that mandatory ATT reporting is prepared and submitted in a timely and complete fashion.
- The WGTR recommends that the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of States Parties adopt a mandate for the Group's work in the period between CSP3 and CSP4 in line with the attached proposal (see separate draft).
