Comments on Argentina Working Paper (29 June 2021)

Dear Secretariat

In response to Japan's statement, we – as stated during the session – would propose the following language as a compromise:

States are encouraged, taking into account their national capacities, to ~~carry out on-site verifications~~ engage in post-delivery cooperation ~~of~~ regarding exports and imports and to exchange information on issued authorizations and the mentioned ~~verifications~~ cooperation with the States involved in the operation in order to facilitate early detection of diversion during international transactions.

I would like to emphasize that we fully support the original language. But if the original language is not acceptable to some states, we propose the language above.
