EIGHTH CONFERENCE OF STATES PARTIES TO THE ATT**

**Rounding out risk assessment under the ATT:**  
factoring in corruption and exploring export reassessment practices

This event will focus on two important and complementary aspects of the risk assessment process under the Arms Trade Treaty (ATT): the application of the export reassessment provisions under Article 7.7, and inserting corruption considerations into arms transfers decisions. Each of these issues have so far received comparatively limited attention from ATT stakeholders, and would benefit from greater focus on the part of national licencing authorities as well as within the ATT formal process. This event will focus on each issue in its own right before discussing possible points of intersection – including how states would respond to new evidence of corruption after a licence has been authorised under Article 7.7.
