ATT-BAP has examined trends in ATT reporting to identify good practices as well as challenges to comprehensive reporting and will launch its report “Lessons Learned from Arms Trade Reporting” to support the work of States, the Working Group, and the ATT Secretariat. This event will include discussion from ATT Monitor and CAVR on the trends, challenges, and good practices in ATT reporting for both the initial report and annual report and offer a series of recommendations to improve ATT reporting efforts.
